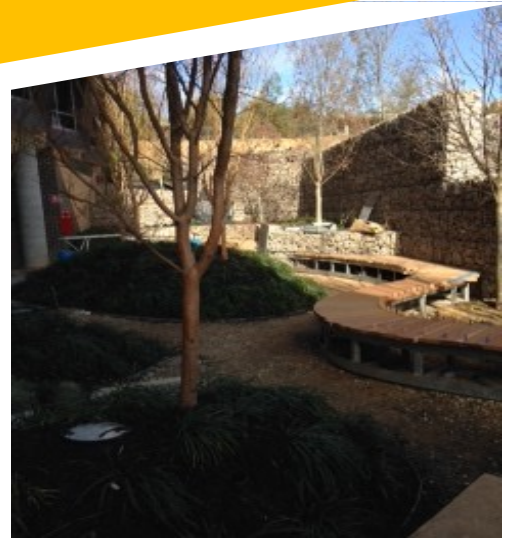


AWRCC Update
